Romney to Highlight Water Wins in Infrastructure Bill During Visit to Central Utah Water Conservancy District

SALT LAKE CITY—On Friday, November 12, U.S. Senator Mitt Romney (R-UT) will visit the *Central Utah Project Completion Act* (CUPCA) construction site in South Utah County to highlight how the recently passed bipartisan *Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act* will help improve Utah's water infrastructure. The legislation, authored and negotiated by Senator Romney and his colleagues, includes \$50 million in funding for the *Central Utah Project Completion Act*, which provides water for both municipal and recreational use throughout Utah. During his visit, Romney will meet with officials from the Central Utah Water Conservancy District, participate in a tour of the facility with local officials, and hold a press conference.
